Scotch Whisky Allergen Statement

Spirit drinks, such as Scotch whisky, made from cereals have been demonstrated to be free from allergens and as such are exempt from allergen labelling requirements. This exemption is documented in EU Directive 2007/68 (amending 2000/13). We have assessed our production process from primary production through blending and bottling and can confirm there are no allergen containing ingredients used in our process.

Therefore, the following products do not contain allergens:

Cutty Sark Blended Scotch whisky
